Introduction

This Apprenticeship Assessment Plan (AAP) sets out the requirements for the assessment of the level 4 warehouse manager apprenticeship. It should be read in conjunction with the General Requirements for Apprenticeship Assessment. Where there is conflict between this AAP and the General Requirements, this AAP takes precedence. Assessment organisations must also comply with the relevant regulatory framework for apprenticeship assessment.

It is important that the assessment of apprentices is proportionate, valid, and provides reliable evidence of an apprentice's attainment of the relevant knowledge and skills. As such, apprenticeship assessment must ensure:

- employers have confidence that the apprentice has reached the expected performance standard
- apprentices are sufficiently secure in their knowledge and skills, so that they could demonstrate their competence in different contexts, for example, a different workplace

Mandatory qualification

The qualification detailed in the occupational standard must be achieved before the end of the apprenticeship.

Assessment Outcomes

The knowledge and skills within the occupational standard fully align with the outcomes listed in the qualification. Therefore, the qualification's assessment result shall confirm apprenticeship completion.

Apprentices are not required to undertake any additional assessments.
